

Notice of Race

for the

R6m National on Sunday 28th June 2009

We extend a very warm welcome to you and your members to this National event. Come and enjoy racing your R6m at the **1 day National at Bournville MYPBC**.

For those of you who have not been before, you will find Bournville lake easily. The post code for the Sat Nav is B30 1QS and with a good old-fashioned map it looks best to approach from the A38 Bristol Road and turn off at its junction with Bournville Lane - there is a big police station on the corner. This is $\frac{3}{4}$ mile south west of the A38 Bristol Road / A4040 OakTree Lane Harborne Lane junction. The lake is then 300 yards on your left.

We hope that the conditions will be ideal, sunny with a good wind straight up and down the lake and no fog, rain or other excuses to prevent us doing our utmost to make the best of it! Mike Harris will be the PRO, the current MYA 6metre class rules will apply and the racing will be conducted using the RRS 2005-2008 modified by sailing instructions that relate to EORS 2001. The relevant notices are as follows:

BRIEFING - this will start at approximately 09.40 hours.
RACING TIMES - the first race will start soon after the briefing at approximately 10.00 hours - no race will start after 15.40 hours and any race in progress at 16.20 hours will be abandoned.
PROTESTS - these will be submitted orally.

For those who don't have a copy of EORS 2001 and related SSIs (March 09 edition), copies will be available on the day. Please remember to bring your MYA membership card, PSN certificate and boat certificate. Please make sure that your correct sail numbers are clearly displayed on all your sails. Where there is more than one boat with the same number, we will inform you prior to the event as to the prefix or the modification of your number.

The entry fee will be £7.50, to be paid on the day. Entries should go to Mike Harris on 01384 262585 or Bill Green on 0121 705 4478 and may be either phoned through or e-mailed to bill_green@blueyonder.co.uk before midnight on **Monday 22nd June 2009**. **This is a later date than published in the MYA YearBook**. The information required is your name, club, sail number, **radio frequency that you have in your boat** and **the alternatives available**. Please encourage as many of your members as possible to take part as this event has created lots of really good racing in past years: pass this notice on to those you know who might like to participate. If they have no R6m, we have some that may be borrowed. Please ring Bill or Mike.
